In the way that we utilize resources.

In reference to "how long human ecological systems can be expected to be usefully productive".

Implied preference, would be for systems, to be indefinitely, or **sustainable**.

Required burial systems expected to spare the earth.

The approach of our firm to burial practice is environmentally friendly and utilizes the minimum area.

By applying the burial system of **dense burial**, like those we developed,

(while observing traditional burial practices -Jewish*, Christian and Muslim),

the earth will stay green and sustainable for the coming generations - our responsibility to our children and grandchildren.

In Israel we have been challenged by the scarcity of land for burial and the high cost of virgin grounds.

In response, we have developed several innovative systems, including **dense burial** cemeteries, using ancient burial methods, like **hillside burial**, **above burial** and others, which we have updated to contemporary technologies.

Our methods can increase up to ten times the number of burials planned for a cemetery.

This means: allocation of new burial grounds can be postponed for many years ahead.

Up to the present, we have planed and applied modifications, in more than fifteen locations in Israel.

As well as in Moscow and Los Angeles.
